HARRY'S HEARTBEAT- Many times in funerals we make mention of the legacy that the person left behind. Each life touches other lives in seen and unseen ways. A person's influence can continue to be felt even after they are gone. Usually we don't like to think about this because (1) we associate legacies with dying and we don't particularly enjoy thinking about that topic; (2) we assume that since our legacy won't be revealed for years, we don't need to start thinking about it now; (3) We feel like we've little or no contact over what we leave behind.

It's one thing to measure our legacy by the money in the bank account, the size of our estate holdings, or the value of the stock we have. These are tangibles. But it's entirely another thing to measure it by intangibles like being a faithful, loving spouse, rearing godly children, being a faithful provider for your family, being a faithful spiritual leader in your home, and letting your light shine on when you're gone. Prov. 13:22 says: “A good man (woman) leaves an inheritance (legacy) to his children and children's children.” What will your legacy be? You have a choice. I love You, Harry
