All 9 of us to go back to Heathers and stay in her 3 BR with no power for days.

Yes, I believe I heard God whisper. You go, Girl. Go visit Sunni. Get out of Pleasant Grove. I also believe He urged others to leave, for whatever reason. If you look, you can see the hand prints of the angels holding down my weak roof. The only tree left standing was the one next to basement Bennie was in. Had it fell, he could have been killed or trapped. Yeah, I'll tell my story, Jesus held us April 27 in His Hand,"
