HARRY'S HEARTBEAT – All of us have stupid things that fascinate us. I have always liked chains of any kind. The flexibility of a chain makes it impossible to kink or break when used properly. Its strength depends on each link, passing the load on to the next link. As kids, we made chains out of paper strips. Then came those famous chain letters that you didn't dare break by not passing them on. Chains, Chains, Chains.

I remember reading about another chain story that fascinated me, I have kept it for years. It started when a Mr. Kimbrell, a Sunday School teacher in Boston, led a shoe clerk to Christ in 1958.

The clerk, Dwight L. Moody, became an Evangelist in England in 1879 and awakened an evangelistic zeal in the heart of Frederick B. Meyer, pastor of a small rural church.

F.B. Meyer, preaching to an American college campus brought a student named J. Wilbur Chapman to Christ.

Chapman engaged in Y.M.C.A work, employed a former baseball player, Billy Sunday, to do evangelistic work.

Billy Sunday held a revival in Charlotte N.C. A group of local men were so impressed afterward that they planned another revival campaign, bringing Mardecai Hamm to town to preach.

During Hamm's revival, a young man named Billy Graham heard the gospel and was saved. On March 16, 1935, Harry Sims was saved and another link in the chain. And God's chain goes on to eternity. Has your name been added to the chain? If not, why?
