From the Fairfield Highland Messenger October 15, 1978

"MY DEAR PEOPLE

No one reading the New Testament objectively can deny that God has a unique plan for every Christian during his life on earth. God desires that every believer be a functioning member of a local church – a local "body" or "family" of believers. These believers should mutually care for one another, minister to one another, and build up one another in Christ.

Again and again New Testament writers exhorted believers to engage in specific activities that would enable the body of Christ to function effectively and to grow spiritually. In the Epistles the expression "One Another" is used 58 times.

Eleven times we are told to love one another in the Epistles. Five times Jesus said in John's Gospel to love one another.

To love fellow believers is a basic command in the New Testament. "A new commandment I give you: Love One Another as I have loved you, so you must love one another. All men will know that you are my disciples if you love one another." John 13:34-35

Receive God's love for you and become a channel of God's love through you.
