I love you and look forward to worship and fellowship with you this week.

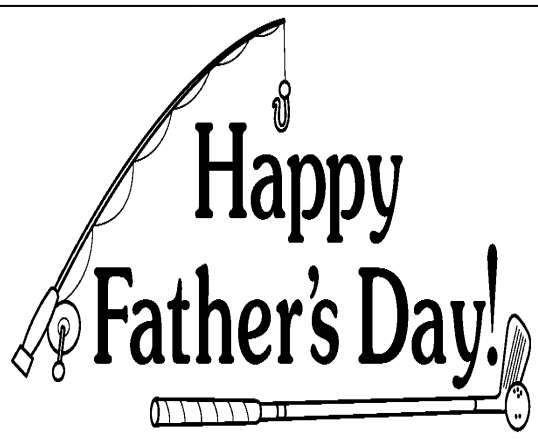
